

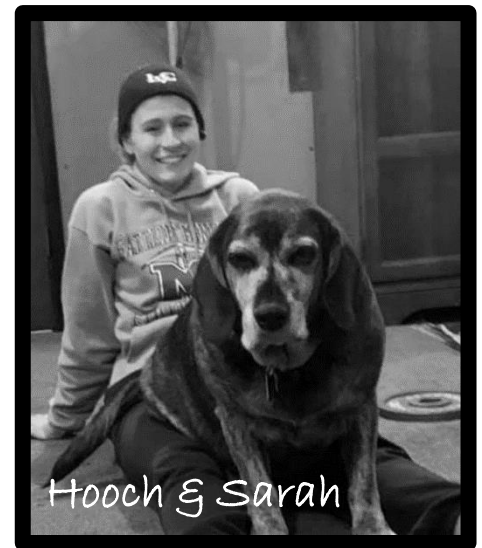

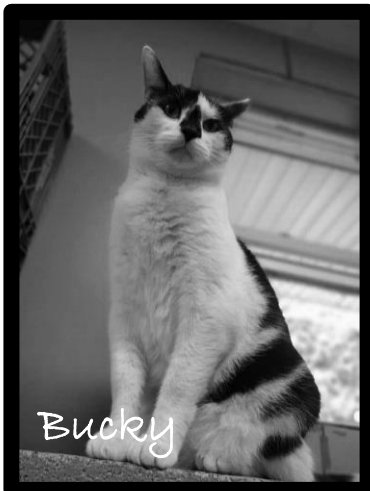

The greatness of a nation and its moral progress can be judged by the way its animals are treated.

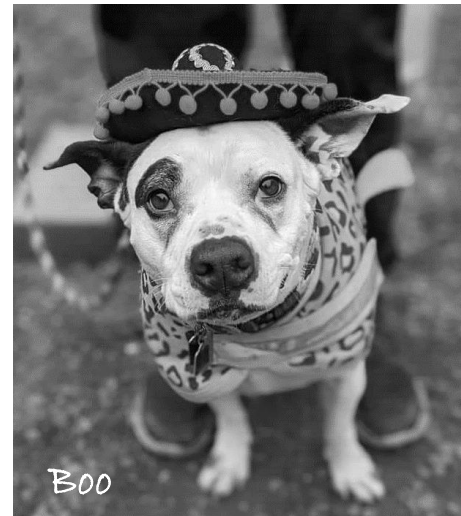

TIMOTHY AND YOU

Timothy was found in a crate along the side of a road by a kind passerby who stopped to check it. Imagine how terrified this kitty felt; all alone, squeezed into a crate with traffic whizzing by! He was brought to us (thank you, dear caring people) and was evaluated by our staff. A quick glance told us Timothy had a problem with his eyes and a veterinarian verified our concern. Timothy was diagnosed with bilateral entropion (his eyelashes turn inward and rub the surface of the eye causing painful irritation and possible corneal damage) and yes, his left cornea was very seriously damaged. He needed special surgery. This was not the diagnosis we expected. Along with the surgery to correct his eyelids, the dead corneal tissue needed to be removed and a tissue graft put in place. This procedure was done by a specialist and can typically cost over \$3000!

Hillside SPCA exists as a refuge for homeless, unwanted, abused and injured animals. Thanks to you, our generous donors, we lovingly care for all that come to us. You are all amazing! You keep our doors open by donating to our general fund. You make it possible for broken animals, such as Timothy, to become whole again by donating to Joe and Caroline's Fund. Our residents, including Timothy, love you for it.

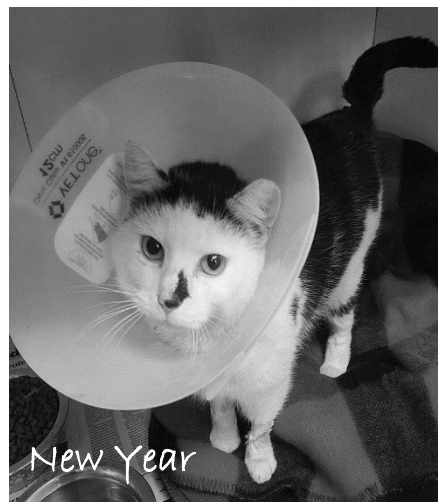


Helping Miracles Happen

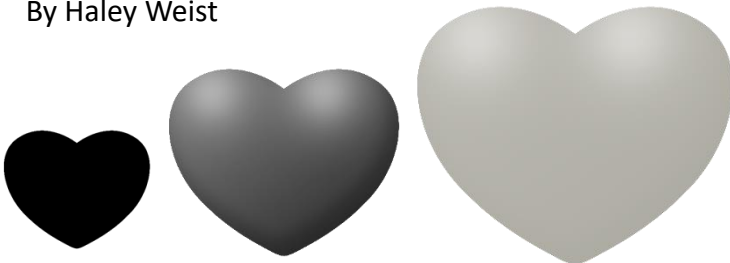

Winter Weather Warnings

As we get out our winter coats, hats and gloves to brave the elements, it is important to remember that our furry friends also need some extra TLC during the colder months.

Thinner dogs get cold quicker than more solid animals with thicker and darker colored coats. A dog with a thick coat like a Husky will be able to stay out in the cold for much longer than a dog with a very thin coat, such as a Greyhound. Also, if dogs have a darker coat they will remain warm on sunny days since their coat will absorb heat from the sunlight. Dogs can go outside for 15 to 20 minutes at below-freezing temperatures to use the bathroom and play, but if the temperature drops below 20 degrees Fahrenheit, dogs could potentially develop cold-associated health issues like hypothermia and frostbite.

Another health hazard you need to watch out for in the winter is the salt that is used to de-ice roads and walkways. It can cause your dog's paw pads to peel off, leaving a layer of fresh, sensitive skin exposed which can be painful to walk on. Make sure to wash your dog's feet with warm water when they return indoors.

You should also steer your dog clear of icy areas because they can fall and hurt themselves just like humans, especially older dogs that may not be able to react as fast.

Keep your pets indoors where you can snuggle up to keep each other warm.

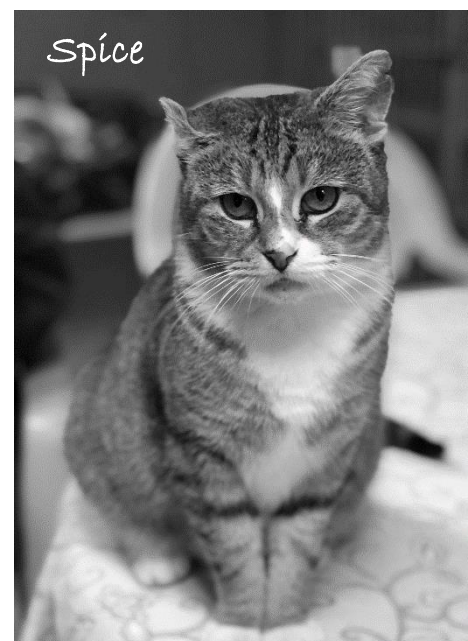
