What a difference 18 months makes. We are a year and a half into our Capital Campaign and we have been able to build a new Welcome Center, build a Memorial Garden, dedicated to Barbara Umlauf, and convert the former Meet and Greet Building into a spay/neuter clinic, which is a monumental accomplishment. This clinic was Barbara's dream and the ultimate goal for the shelter. Hillside SPCA is pleased to announce that we are opening Spay/Neuter Services to the public on a limited basis, effective immediately. The general public may call (570) 622-7769 to schedule a spay/neuter appointment. Our thanks goes out to the community for the outpouring of love and

support for this Campaign. Without you, we could never have done any of this. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts and paws.

We are commencing phase two of the Campaign, which will involve the construction of 38 new kennels in the Small and Big Dog Buildings, new cat condos with a new floor, and a new cat solarium. We also need to replace the doors and windows in all three of the animal housing buildings as many of the windows no longer open. JELD-WEN has very generously donated all of the windows for this next phase of the project. We are so appreciative of the support of JELD-WEN Windows and Doors. Our kennels and cat condos have never been replaced in 35 years so they are completely rusted out, as is our kitty solarium on the back of the cat building.

Because of the love and support of our friends and the community, this Capital Campaign has come a long way in a very short amount of time. Hopefully, with the ongoing support of our friends, we will soon have a safe, warm, renovated facility we can all be proud of.

Thank you so much for always being there for us in our times of need. You are all amazing! With the addition of a much needed spay/neuter clinic, our commitment to helping the animals of our community will continue for many years to come.
